The area by the entrance has been a wildflower area since the park was created 20+ years ago but gradually as the trees have been getting larger, they have started to reduce the amount of sun light getting to the wildflowers.

For the past couple of years, the group has been cutting out new saplings and cutting back any over grown branches to allow more light to flood in again. We are also been removing large amounts of thatch from summer growth to help reduce the nutrients going back into the soil. This brash has then been used to create large habitat piles for local wildlife to use



For the last couple of years, the wildflowers here have flourished and I am sure we will have a great show again next year.
