

The rain and wind of the previous few days subsided and we had a lovely morning to do a quick tidy and some sweeping along this jitty.

We've cut back the overgrowth on a few occasions and some of the greener waste has already decayed to almost nothing in just over 10 months. The larger brown waste, the branches from the larger shrubs, will take a lot more time yet, but is starting to provide habitat for small insects and mammals. Some of this was tidied up and moved further back behind the shrubs to get it to decay as quickly as possible. The paths were swept and the leaf debris moved under the shrubs to show the edges to the paths and reduce future growth creeping onto the path.
